

Message and Welcome from the Mayor

Come and celebrate the spectacular return of the Northam May Fair on the 30th April 2022. This year, the Fair promises to be bigger and better than ever, with new attractions, including Walking Dinosaurs. The entire village centre will be lined with stalls from Northam Hall to the Square and along Cross Street to the Methodist Church. There will be indoor stalls at the Community Centre, Methodist Church and Northam Hall. Once again, the Rectory Gardens will be hosting the Arenas for your favourites, Viking reenactments, Dinosaur Shows, Miniature Steam Train rides, Merlin's circus school & show, Exmoor Zoo, and Magic Punch & Judy.

The day starts at 10 in the morning outside Northam Library with a parade including a Children's Fancy Dress competition, with the theme "The Oueen's Platinum Jubilee".

There is something for everyone ... come and join the fun. See you there!

We would also like to thank all who are involved in the May Fair, everyone from the visitors, stall holders, volunteer marshals and organisers to all of the Northam Town Council staff who work so hard throughout the year. The fair would not be the great success it is without any of you!

The History of our May Fair

The Northam May Fair has been held for around 40 years. In the 1980s there were regular tug of war contests in Fore Street as part of the fair usually between the two public houses that are in Northam, (The Golden Lion and The Kingsley Inn), with all the events taking place in the Square. In later years the May Fair didn't take place but was revived in 2012 by the new Vicar, supported by volunteers. In 2017 it was decided by the organisers that with insufficient volunteers to continue running the event, so Northam Town Council stepped in to make sure it could go ahead. The Council have been responsible for the running of the May Fair ever since.
