North Devon and Torridge District Councils sought only representatives of the property and development industry to sit on the HELAA stakeholder panel, the communities being represented by one elected member of one of the two district councils.

The proposed extension was out of keeping with the immediate neighbourhood, being overbearing

in design and character and would detrimentally affect the street scene.

The proposal would be visible from the Northam Burrows, an SSSI within the undeveloped coast.

Additionally, the Council echoes the concerns of the North Devon Coast AONB Officer. The impact of the light emitted through the large areas of gazing onto the Burrows, a site of special scientific interest. The effect of the light at night would have a detrimental effect on wildlife, the dark skies, and peaceful environment of the Burrows, which is a part of the AONB.
